School Policy **Dress Code**

One of the school regulations is to dress appropriately.

Adults

All adults in Simprug are role models for our students. Therefore, adults working in or visiting the School wear respectable attire. Items of clothing should be neither brief nor revealing. As an example, skirts and short dresses should have hems touching or slightly above knees.

Students

Official School Uniform

Uniform must be kept clean, pressed and in good repair. Any part of the uniform which is lost, stained or damaged should be replaced.

PE Uniform

For all students in EL to HS, the PE uniform is worn only during physical education, fitness or other sporting activities, and not during normal classes. It consists of a T-shirt and sports pants with a specific school design.

Students in EL to HS may wear their PE uniform from home if a PE or Fitness lesson occurs in Session 1 and/or 2. Official school uniform is then worn after the lesson has finished.

EY children may wear the PE uniform throughout the days on which they have PE lessons.

Accessories

Permitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wrist watch • Plain white undershirts that are not visible • Black jackets/sweaters, either with School Crest or plain (without hoods or other logos/designs) • For girls only, one stud earring in each lobe
Not Permitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wrist bands of any material • Necklaces of leather or not of simple gold/silver design • Earrings/studs for boys • Coloured contact lens

Personal Appearance

As illustrated in the pictures,

hair must be clean and neatly groomed at all times

Boys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair must not touch the eyebrows, ears or shirt collar • Gels are allowed, if hair is neatly groomed • For older boys, face must be clean shaven
Girls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair must be held back off the face and eyebrows
Not Permitted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make-up • Dyeing or tinting of hair • Nail polish • Extreme shaven heads • Mohawk style • Brightly coloured ribbons or hair combs • Tattoos
